



Hosting a postage party

What is a postage party?

It's a group of your friends getting together to address candidate postcards in your zip code to your friends and neighbors, place postage on the cards and mail them out. It's simple, fun and similar to old fashioned group gatherings to socialize around a good cause.

How To:

1. Contact Sara and let her know you want to host a postage party – you can do this via her website, email, Facebook page or just give her a call.
2. Contact as few or as many friends who you think might want to help and invite them to your house for the event.
3. Sara will give you a list of names in your ZIP Code – feel free to pick and choose amongst the names, just make sure you notate who's getting cards from your postage party as we may have other parties in your ZIP Code hosting similar events.
4. We provide as many cards as you think you will need – you and your group provide the labor and stamps.
5. Divide up your list amongst your friends (they can pick the names they know as well – just remember to notate who they choose) and asked them to address no less than five cards based on the list – they can do as many as they want but we ask that they do at least five. ***Nothing wrong with putting a short note on any card where you know the addressee.***
6. If all you're doing at your party is having card's addressed – great! Once they've done collect the cards, notate the names chosen and return them to Sara – if you are providing postage as well - put the postage on the cards and drop them off at your local post office.

That's it – send Sara an email letting or how many you've done and drop off your ***notated*** list Sara's home of those sent – please write a total on the page so we don't have to count – we're not lazy, just looking for ways to save time and energy for other election events.

Thanks for all your help. Remember, the goal of a postage party to get as many cards out as possible in your **ZIP Code** and your efforts are greatly appreciated.
